About the Garden Route Adventure

Our *Adventure Motorcycle Tour* gives you a different perspective to this beautiful part of Africa. *It* starts and ends in **Cape Town**. We first explore the ins and outs of **Cape Town** and its surroundings. We ride to the **Cape of Goodhope** and the **Cape Point National Park**. From **Table Mountain** our travels take you to the **southern most tip of Africa, L'Agulhas**. We briefly visit South Africa's *whale watching mecca - Hermanus*.

We explore the easy-to-navigate gravel roads of the **Garden Route** as we traverse the **Overberg Region**. We cross the **Breede River** using the only *hand drawn pontoon* in SA. At **Bloukrans Bridge**,

home to the highest commercial **bungee jump operation** (216m) in the world, you might have a chance to conquer your fears. After a short stay over in **Knysna** and visiting the **Tsitsikamma Coastal Park**, we arrive in the **Eastern Cape Province**.

We go on *safari* in the **Addo National Elephant Park** to look for the **Big 5** – lion, elephant, rhino, leopard and buffalo. Following our safari, we journey inland to conquer the rugged, yet spectacular **Baviaans Kloof** (Baboon Gorge). This vast mega reserve with its abundant wildlife now includes recently introduced rhinos.

From the **Baviaans Kloof**, we head to the **Gamka Kloof**, aka “the Hell”. Few can boast “they have been to hell and back” and lived to tell the tale.

We head back to the **Cape Winelands** via **Route 62**. This route is said to be the longest wine route in the world. We head back to Cape Town traveling along the northern slopes of the **Langeberge Mountain Range** before we reach **Robertson**, capital of the **Breede River Valley**....our last stop before Cape Town.



About the ride

Rating - A moderate ride with easygoing packed gravel roads except in the **Baviaans Kloof** for 80km.

Pillions - this ride is suitable for experienced pillions.

Gravel vs. Asphalt - approximately 50% of the distance will be on packed gravel roads and the rest on good asphalt.

Minimum group size - 6 riders
