### About the Garden Route Tour

Our Garden Route Motorcycle Tour starts and ends in **Cape Town**. The *Mother City* has a rare **cosmopolitan** vibe which encapsulates the visitor, let alone having the sheer natural beauty of the Western Cape constantly in your face. One tends to forget that you are in Africa!

Riders will experience an enjoyable balance between riding and enjoying a well deserved vacation. We aim to give you the best of both worlds whilst exploring South Africa's coastline - getting to know all about its **cultural diversities** and natural beauty.

We spend a few days to explore the ins and outs of *Cape Town* and its surroundings.

The city has a lot to enjoy and explore. From **Table Mountain**, our travels takes you to the southern most **tip of Africa**, L'Agulhas. We ride via *Hermanus*, South Africa's famous whale watching mecca. We discover the magnificent vistas of the **Garden Route** making our way to Knysna. We visit the Bloukrans Bridge, the highest commercial bungee jump operation (216m) in the world.

Next is the Eastern Cape Province with **Port Elizabeth** our end destination. It was originally home to the 1820 British Settlers. We go on **safari** in the **Addo Elephant Park** to look for

the **Big 5** - lion, elephant, rhino, leopard and buffalo. Then we journey inland to visit Graaff-Reinet in the heart of the **Great Karoo**. This stretch out semi arid region is reminiscent of the American Wild West. We enter the **Little Karoo** and head for **Oudtshoorn**, ostrich capital of the world. We learn more about these big birds and explore the **wango Caves**. We head back to the heart of the Cape Winelands via **Route 62**. Aptly we end our tour with a last night to be enjoyed in **Stellenbosch**, South Africa's second oldest town.
