We collect our motorcycles nice and early to ensure enough time to cover the distance for the day on our ride. We leave the hustle and the bustle of **Cape Town** behind us as we head out of town towards the **Cape Winelands** region. We have a wide choice of routes to follow to ensure maximum fun and riding.

Our route includes various stops at sightseeing venues such as the **Afrikaans Language Monument** - the only monument of its kind to commemorate a language, and the **Drakenstein Prison**. **Mr. Nelson Mandela** took his first step to freedom from the gates of this prison and to celebrate this a giant statue of him has been erected at this spot. The route includes some of the most scenic **mountain passes** and we cross the Du Toitskloof and Drakenstein Mountains on more than one occasion. If you love mountain passes – there are 5 to choose from - and superb windy roads, then this ride is for you as it showcases the best the **Cape Winelands** has to offer.
