We leave the **Cape Town** rush behind, collect our motorcycles and head towards the remote **Tankwa Karoo**. Our aim is to enjoy the *lesser travelled roads* and thus we traverse scenic mountain passes and visit remote areas. These include some interesting routes such as *Kabakkies Pass*, *Ouberg Pass* and *Gydo Pass*. They all lead to the hinterland as we ascend the Roggeveld escarpment on the outskirts of *Sutherland*, **South Africa's astronomical capital**.

We continue along the gravel roads winding through the desolate **Moordenaars Karoo** (Murderers Karoo) as we near the **Seweweekspoort Pass**, undoubtedly one of the most spectacular passes in South Africa. The *Karoo* back roads ascending the **Swarthberg Pass** leads us to the **Gamkaskloof**, also known as "*the Hell*". Tonight we are surrounded by the majestic Swarthberg Mountains and the silence in this remote valley.

After a well deserved nights rest, we continue along the *Karoo back-roads* to **Meirings Poort Pass**. We stop in Willowmore before heading into the **Baviaanskloof Mega Reserve**. Numerous wildlife are found in these mountains and recently they reintroduced the White Rhinoceros. Not only will the off-road conditions demand that we stop frequently, but also will the breathtaking scenery surrounding us!

We continue towards **Addo Elephant Park**. We leave our motorcycles behind to enjoy a short *safari* to find the Big 5. Our journey takes us to the Garden Route as we ride through the dense **Tsitsikamma forests** stopping at the **Tsitsikamma Coastal Park** and *Bloukrans Bridge* - the world's highest bungee jump operation (216m). In **Knysna** we enjoy the luxury the Knysna Waterfront affords us after experiencing the remoteness of the Baviaanskloof.

We leave the best for last as we sweep along the back roads past the "sleeping beauty" – a well known rock formation on the N2. At **Malgas** we cross the Breede River via the last hand-drawn pontoon in South Africa. More gravel roads lead us to the **southern tip of Africa**, Cape Agulhas. Thereafter we head back home via **Clarence Drive** along the eastern shores of **False Bay**.

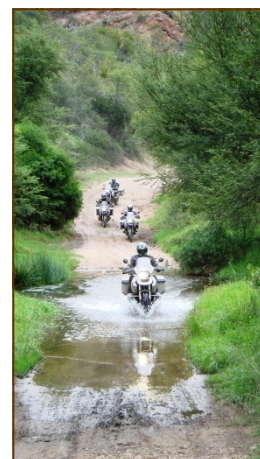
Rating - An easy going ride.
